> Recycling contamination happens when wellintended recyclers mistakenly put the wrong items into their recycling. It can wreak havoc on the recycling process in Cuyahoga County and throughout the world.

> Here in Cuyahoga County, the best way to avoid recycling contamination in your curbside recycling is to recycle only these five core items:

CANS: Empty and rinse.

CARTONS: Empty and rinse. Replace the cap it's too small to be recycled by itself!

GLASS BOTTLES & JARS: Empty and rinse.

PAPER & BOXES: Flatten cardboard items, like cereal boxes, to save space.

PLASTIC BOTTLES & JUGS: Empty and rinse. Replace the cap.

Place these items loose - not bagged - in your recycling bin or cart. All items should be empty, clean and dry. Plastic bottles and jugs includes items with an opening or neck that is narrower than the body.
